### CONDITIONS:

1. All cattle must be on the grounds by 6pm on April 26th 2019. Feeding in yards not permitted
  2. Judging will commence at 9am on Saturday April 27th 2019
  3. The Society will take no responsibility other than the feeding and watering of cattle on the grounds till 3pm last day of Show.
  4. Owners to assist with sorting & penning as directed by the Chief Steward.
  5. All cattle must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor for three months prior to the Show. All cattle are received subject to the right of the Stewards to reject any cattle not up to the Show standard and, if required, to arrange for same to be removed from the grounds before judging commences.
  6. Stewards have the right to transfer any entry to a more suitable class.
  7. All cattle must be either polled or completely dehorned and wild cattle must be removed from the grounds at the discretion of the Stewards.
  8. Cattle cannot compete in more than one class excepting the carcass classes. A freshly erupted or lost tooth shall be counted.
  9. Cattle may be mouthed one week prior to the Show by arrangements with the Secretary or Chief Steward.
  10. Champions may be selected from a pen or single classes.
  11. Exhibitors must include Vendors Declaration Forms for Carcass Cattle.
- Home cattle will only require a Nomination Form which covers movement to and from the showgrounds.
12. No cattle will be accepted as non-competitive.
  13. All exhibitors & the public must remain outside the yards while judging is in progress.
  14. Breed of cattle to be stated on entry form or handed to the Steward on the first day of the Show.
  15. Classes 1, 2, 5, 6, 14 and 15 must be pasture or crop fed. Not grain assisted.
  16. Cattle entered in Prime Beef Section to remain in cattle yards to 3pm on the last day of the Show.
  17. Cattle must be free of ticks and must meet DPI standards.
  18. In all pen classes, at least one beast must have stated number of teeth, others may have less.
  19. All stock must carry an NLIS device.
  20. Cattle must be off properties with a JBAS 6 or Higher—please be aware that cattle in Single Beast Classes are penned together. Please be aware that cattle are penned next to other cattle and can have nose to nose contact.
  21. Classes 9,10,11,17 & 18 will be weighed on Friday afternoon during processing.

# Prime Cattle - Carcass Competition

## Conditions

1. All carcass cattle to be HGP FREE
  2. Cattle will be mouthed at works
  3. All cattle entered will be identified and judged by the ABCAM system at works.
  4. Selling agents may act for owners. Account sales will be debited with normal selling charges including freight from Monto. Date of slaughter will be available from the Secretary
  5. Where minimum and maximum carcass weight apply, a tolerance of 10 kg will be allowed with a penalty of 1 point per kg, and disqualification outside the tolerance. All cattle entered will be slaughtered at Meatworks appointed by Society and the company will purchase the carcass at ruling rates arranged by the Society
  6. Cattle most suitable for export trade
- Evenness of pen in class 22. 0-20kg -0; 21-30kg -1; 31-40kg -2; 41-50kg -3; 51-60 -4; 61+ -5
