REGULATIONS:

1. All entries must be owned by the exhibitor and submitted on an entry form filled out in advance to assist stewards.
2. Exhibits will be judged based on commercial value, with quality assessed by factors such as maturity, freshness, internal characteristics, and freedom from diseases, insect damage, and blemishes.
3. Uniformity in color, size, and maturity is essential.
4. Judges have the authority to reclassify exhibits if they have been entered incorrectly.
5. Fruit classes, except for watermelons, must be presented on a plate.
6. Citrus classes 1020 to 1033 require only a plate of four, either ripe or green.
