Prizes: 1st \$5, 2nd \$2 where no trophy or donation given

REGULATIONS:

1. Exhibition will be dismantled at 3pm on the last day of the Show and will be available for collection by 3.30pm
2. All exhibits must be the work of the competitor and completed WITHIN THE LAST 3 YEARS
3. The same exhibit cannot compete in more than one class
4. Exhibits to consist of one article only, unless otherwise specified
5. Factory made articles will not be allowed to compete
6. All completed exhibits that have been washed will be disqualified
7. All collections to be clearly grouped
8. The Society reserves the right to refuse any entry (vide By-Laws)
9. Crochet work (Crochet sub-classes) to be mounted (soft cardboard) where applicable
10. Any thickness of mercerised cotton can be used
11. Soiled work definitely will not be judged
12. Exhibits which have won a first prize at a previous Monto Show, are not eligible
13. A Novice is a competitor who has not won a 1st prize in that particular sub-class
14. Prize money for most points will be awarded only if two or more entries are entered
15. Quilts may be professional quilted unless specified
