Led Steers or Heifers are eligible to compete in the Carcass Competition subject to the following rules:

1. Cattle will compete in both the led section and the commercial section and entry fees are payable for both sections. Carcass Entries Close 15th April 2024.
  2. Cattle have to arrive Friday by 5pm and will be housed with the Commercial Cattle and Commercial rules will apply
  3. Strictly no feeding of cattle any time after induction to the commercial yards. Any feeding will result in instant disqualification.
  4. The cattle can be removed from the yards Saturday morning for preparation and showing in the led class. On completion they must return immediately to the commercial yards and halters removed
- Please Note if Entry Numbers exceed 2 competitors a new class will be created in the Carcass Competition and item 2 – 4 will be waived.

1. Monto is a Category 'B' Merit Show for the Beef Sire of the Year Competition.
2. The name of the exhibit and Herd Book number must be stated on entry form.
3. Exhibitors please refer to Regulation 36
4. Birth dates taken from April 1st
5. All exhibits shown in individual classes must have a nose ring or nose clip
6. Open to all recognized Stud Breeds.
7. Any entry may only compete in one class. If a Calf has been exhibited in a calf class it cannot be shown in a Cow & Calf Class
8. All breed entries judged as one class.
9. All stock must carry an NLIS Device.
10. MONTO SHOWGROUNDS PIC No QCMN0635
11. Exhibitors be aware that Monto Showgrounds is in a tick area. Please be aware of your obligations if travelling back into a tick free area. Please contact a Biosecurity Queensland Accredited Certifier if required
12. Biosecurity—Cattle must be off properties with a JBAS 6 or Higher to compete
13. Cattle departure time is to be after the completion of judging for the Junior Stud Judging
