  2. All entries must be on an entry form filled out in advance to help stewards.
  3. All exhibits will be judged on the commercial value
  4. The quality of vegetables shall be assessed by such factors as maturity, freshness, internal characteristics and free from diseases, insect damage and blemishes. Uniformity with regard to colour, size and maturity is essential.
  5. The Judge is empowered to place an exhibit in its correct class if it has been incorrectly placed by an exhibitor.
  6. Exhibitors wishing to donate their exhibits to the Society for sale, please indicate on entry form and advise Stewards
  7. Extra classes will be made if sufficient entries
- HINTS ON BETTER PRESENTATION  
Stems should be cut off evenly.  
Exhibits should be free of dirt or foreign matter.  
Colour to be as stated in the class.
